



Notice of Race & Sailing Instructions

2022 Shaw Island Winter Classic
Saturday, February 12, 2022

Amended February 5, 2022

Our sponsors, the Orcas Hotel, West Sound Marina, and the Orcas Island Yacht Club, are pleased to invite you to participate in the annual Shaw Island Winter Classic sailboat race.

RULES

The regatta will be governed by [The Racing Rules of Sailing](#) (RRS, 2021-2024), the [prescriptions of the U.S. Sailing Association](#), and this Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions. PHRF Rules will be in effect.

RRS 52, Manual Power, is amended to include: Boats entered in the shorthanded division are allowed to use autopilot mechanisms for sail changes and other situations where having one crew member assigned to steering the yacht may compromise the safety of crew and craft.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

All boats must have a valid PHRF certificate or be listed on the current PHRF-NW roster. Boats not meeting this requirement may be disqualified without a hearing. All boats must also meet the [U.S Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements \(SER\)](#) for "Nearshore."

Advance registration is required via the [event site](#).

The owner/skipper and all crew must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 in conformance with [CDC guidelines](#).

DIVISIONS

There will be at least two PHRF divisions—PHRF fully crewed and PHRF shorthanded. Shorthanded is defined as single- or double-handed. A one-design division may be offered if five or more one-design boats register. Divisions will be posted to the [sailing section of OIYC.org under Race Results](#) in advance of the start.

ENTRY FEE AND REGISTRATION

The entry fee is \$45.00. [Click here to register](#).

SCHEDULE

Deadline for registration is February 10, 2021. The regatta will start at or after 1015 on Saturday, depending on ferry traffic. All divisions will start at the same time.

SOCIAL EVENTS

~~Due to COVID-19, no social events are planned. In lieu of the traditional after-race dinner, a gift certificate to Orcas Hotel will be provided to each boat. Information on redeeming the gift certificate will be sent to skippers via email before the race.~~ Fully vaccinated skippers and crew are invited to West Sound Community Hall after racing for a dinner provided by Orcas Hotel, including chili, cornbread, brownies and beer/wine. One meal is included with each boat entry and [additional meals may be purchased from the event site](#).

MOORAGE

Moorage is available at West Sound Marina or the OIYC dock (no power or water), both in West Sound about 20 minutes from the start/finish line. Moorage is free for racers. Call West Sound Marina at 360-376-2314 to reserve dock space. Moorage at the OIYC dock is first-come, first serve for racers who are members of reciprocal yacht clubs.

LAND ACCOMMODATIONS

The Orcas Hotel has rooms available for racers and crew. Call the Orcas Hotel at 360-376-4300 for reservations. Be sure to mention that you are sailing in this race.

COMMUNICATIONS

VHF channel 68 will be used for race communications. Except in the case of an emergency or retirement, radio communications to the race committee are discouraged.

Boats that retire or do not finish by the time limit MUST contact the race committee by VHF channel 68 (and receive a reply), or by phone 360-317-4053 (and leave a voicemail if not answered), or by email to stephanie@dashracing.org by 1715 on the day of racing. Boats that fail to do this will be scored DSQ without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.

SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

All signals will be flown/sounded from the balcony of the Orcas Hotel. The postponement flag will drop promptly after the 1000 ferry departs Orcas Landing for Friday Harbor. Please stay out of the way of all ferries. An announcement will be made by radio VHF channel 68 prior to the start sequence. The starting sequence will be as specified in [RRS Rule 26](#). **Competitors are encouraged to monitor VHF channel 68 during the starting sequence.** The cutoff time for finishing is 1700 hours.

COURSE

The start/finish line will be in Harney Channel. A flag on the upper balcony of the Orcas Hotel will mark the port end of the line. The flagpole on Shaw Island at approximately 48° 35.170 N and 122° 56.534 W will mark the starboard end of the line. The course will be clockwise around Shaw Island.

PROTESTS AND REDRESS

Protests shall be filed in accordance with [RRS 60](#) by 1800. Protest forms will not be provided. On Course Side (OCS) yachts that did not return and properly start will have no grounds for redress. Failure to hear an announcement by the race committee or failure by the race committee to make a broadcast or to time it accurately will not be grounds for a request for redress. This changes [RRS 62.1\(a\)](#).

SCORING

The race will be scored by division using Time on Distance (TOD), where 12 nautical miles will be the reference.

PRIZES

Awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be awarded to each division. Additionally, the fastest overall winner on corrected time will be memorialized on the perpetual trophy on display in the Orcas Hotel dining room.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers (Orcas Island Yacht Club, organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, OIYC Board member, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

INSURANCE

The owner must have third-party liability insurance for their boat, applicable for sailboat racing, having a minimum coverage of \$400,000 USD. If the owner is not on board, the policy must be valid for a non-owner person in charge.
